Treasurer's Report

Gene Burmeister presented the financial report. Our cash position is ahead of last year by \$2,800, but we do still owe \$1,250 to the Meyer, so we will come out slightly ahead of last year. We have \$33k cash on hand, including a CD that matures in May 2018. Gene offered band members a final fiscal year report after year closes on June 30th. Financially, we're in great shape.

President's report

There were numerous thank-yous from Brent and Mike Ajango to the board members, section leaders, librarians, stage attire volunteers, as well as work on publicity, announcing, stage arrangements, and the extra work of hauling percussion equipment with the trailer.

Over the summer, Brent plans to update the member database; he asked band members to let him or Mike Ajango know of any changes to the roster. Rehearsals are scheduled for the 2017-18 season; we are now waiting for the final public school schedule to confirm. Christmas will be at West High School again in 2018.

We are planning a pizza part at the Allouez Center after the Heritage Hill event on June 12th, and all are welcome, regardless of whether they're performing at the event.

Brent reminded band members of the content on the website, and that bylaws are also available online. The easiest way for out-of-state supporters to find us online is Allouez TV on YouTube.

We do expect to do another AVB clothing order at some point in the future, based on demand.

Meeting Business

Elections: Mary Eisenreich and Mary Rehberg are up for re-election for 3 year positions. There were no other nominees, and nobody at the meeting stepped forward to add their name to the ballot.
